DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS **OAK LAWN STREETS LIGHT THE WAY**

All of the street lights on the residential roads have been converted to LED; (2,826). This project was completed over a four year period. The new lights installed are Philips/Lumec LED fixtures. The Village cost for this project was \$1,275,138.80. Of this amount, the Village received Energy Efficiency Grants through DCEO for each year during the project. The Village also received grant monies from the Illinois Clean Energy program...


