- II. Welcome to visitors – **no visitors**
- III. Approval of the September 20, 2017 Meeting Minutes – **LV moved to approve the minutes. SR seconded. All in Favor. Passed Unanimously**
- IV. Report from the Chair – No report. **NG stated that there was a letter that needed to go out to the group for the mandatory meeting in November. LV stated that she received an email about a student liaison to replace Shannon. NG stated that he talked with the mother of the potential student about the opportunity.**
