All of our providers are board certified in family or adult health and can assess, diagnose and treat common illnesses. We see patients who are 3 years of age and older.

- School physicals
- Sports physicals
- Child and adult immunizations
- Minor injury or illness
- DOT and Illinois bus driver physicals and drug screens
- Health program requirements, such as drug screens and titers
- Well-woman and well-child exams
- TB skin testing (PPD)
- Laboratory services
- Biometric screening
- Chronic illness management
- CPR instruction
- Health promotion and education

We are in-network with most PPO insurance plans, including Aetna Multiplan, BC/BS, Humana, Medicare and United Healthcare. Call the health center or check our website for the most up-to-date list.
