


Providing Pathways Home

People Served: South Suburban PADS helps families, Veterans and people with special needs.




FY 16/17 Impact:

- ▶ Engaged 448 people through street outreach
- ▶ Provided emergency shelter for 822 guests
- ▶ Served 34,299 meals
- ▶ Preserved or provided affordable rental homes for 570 residents, including 204 kids

27-Year Impact:

- ▶ Provided emergency shelter for over 17,000 guests

After a few months, he exhausted his savings and became homeless —sleeping in his car or on the couches or the floors of friends.


Fortunately, Casey was able to obtain an affordable rental home at South Suburban PADS’ Country Club Hills Wellness Center.
