THE VILLAGE OF OAK LAWN SALES TAX INFORMATION FOR 2016

Residents should be aware of the new sales tax rate effective January 1st, 2016. The change does not come from the Village of Oak Lawn but from Cook County for an overall increase from 8.75% to 9.75%. There is no impact on food or prescription drugs which are taxed at 2.25%. There is no impact on titled goods (cars, trucks, etc.) which are taxed at 7.25%. Oak Lawn ranks 19th out of 1,299 Illinois municipalities in total sales tax revenue for its diversified tax base.




OAK LAWN POLICE NEWS COMMUNITY SAFETY UPDATE
