MARIANO'S FRESH MARKET COMING TO OAK LAWN!

- Mariano's is owned by Roundy's Supermarkets, a Milwaukee-based company whose CEO, Robert Mariano, is a Chicago native and former Dominick's CEO.
- The first store was opened in July 2010, in Arlington Heights and Oak Lawn will be the 10th announced Mariano's store. Site work will likely begin this summer and culminate in a 4th quarter of 2014 store opening. The Oak Lawn store will feature an upscale architectural aesthetic with a prominent rotunda, similar to the Vernon Hills store, with heated floors.
- Mariano's is known for its neighborhood shopping environment and for incorporating amenities like an Italian coffee shop, a sushi/oyster bar with on-site chef, a wine and cheese shop, and a full service pharmacy. All stores focus on the theme, "Shop well. Eat well. Live well."



- Mariano's combines the offerings of traditional and specialty markets, with an emphasis on fresh produce, from locally grown food to products imported from the world over. Standard grocery fare is complimented with products typically found at Trader Joe's or Whole Foods.
- About 400 people will be employed at the 70,000 square-foot Oak Lawn store and an emphasis is being placed on providing Oak Lawn customers with ample parking as warranted by the incredible volume seen at other stores. During construction, 65 workers are generally on site every day.
- The Village believes that Mariano's quality and passion for service will be a draw for other quality retail and restaurant establishments and this public-private partnership along with Hamilton Partners will leverage its resources to the fullest with regard to future recruitment efforts.



Women and Infants Center Tour – A complimentary tour is available of the Labor and Delivery and the Family Centered Care Units to orientate expectant parents to these areas. Tours will be offered on Mondays, **March 4 and March 18**, at 6:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. **Code: 1B12**

Childbirth Education – This class meets once a week for four weeks. The program is designed to help prepare couples for childbirth.
