



Enrollment Fairs

Apply for NO COST Health Insurance part of the Affordable Care Act and through a brand new Illinois Medicaid program called CountyCare.

Cook County Commissioner Joan Patricia Murphy is hosting CountyCare Enrollment Fairs on June 26, 2013 and June 27, 2013. Applications will be taken on site.

If you live in Cook County and are uninsured or underinsured, you may be eligible to receive no cost health insurance through CountyCare. Once enrolled into the program, CountyCare members will receive primary care service, hospitalization, prescription drugs, lab X-rays, mammograms, mental health and substance abuse programs, plus many more healthcare services. Quality services will be available at all Cook County Health and Hospital sites plus local participating hospitals and Federal Qualified Health Care Centers.

To qualify you must live in Cook County, are 19—64 years old, have a Social Security number and be a legal immigrant for 5 years or more. Yearly income guidelines must be below \$15,282 for an individual or \$20,628 per couple. Must not be receiving or eligible for Medicaid, Medicare or CHIP. To enroll bring proof of identity, proof of citizenship, proof of Cook County residency, proof of income for the last 30 days.

Commissioner Murphy “encourages all qualified residents to attend the Enrollment Fairs and start an active plan for increased health and wellness.”

CountyCare Enrollment Fairs will be co-hosted at convenient area locations on Wednesday, June 26, 2013 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at Moraine Valley Community College located at 9000 West College Parkway, Building M in Palos Hills. Thursday, June 27, 2013 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at Prairie State Community college, Conference Center, Room #1315 located at 202 South Halsted Street in Chicago Heights.




District 123: Sidewalk Art Festival


Lunchtime @ the Library


Cemeteries around Chicagoland


