OAK LAWN SALES TAX REVENUE UP IN 3RD QUARTER

Through the third quarter, Village sales tax revenue was above budget by \$265,483 and ahead of last year's pace by \$245,829. In addition, effective July 1, 2012 the Village's home rule sales tax rate increased from .5% to .75% which is projected to result in an increase in sales tax revenue of approximately \$100,000 per month beginning with October's receipts due to the 90-day processing delay with state. Through October, Village sales tax revenue was above budget by \$414,562 and ahead of October 2011 by \$368,173. The additional home rule sales taxes were estimated to be approximately \$80,000 in October from the rate increase for July sales transactions.


