



## Grilling Safety Tips

- Propane & charcoal BBQ grills should only be used outdoors.
- The grill should be placed well away from the home, deck railings & out from under eaves & overhanging branches.
- Keep children & pets away from the grill area.
- Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup from the grills & in trays below the grill.
- Never leave your grill unattended.

### Propane Grills:

- Check the gas tank hose for leaks before using it for the first time each year. Apply a light soap & water to the hose. A propane leak will release bubbles.
- If your grill has a gas leak, by smell or the soapy bubble test, & there is no flame, turn off the gas tank & grill. If the leak stops, get the grill serviced by a professional before using it again. If the leak does not stop, call the fire department.
- If you smell gas while cooking, immediately get away from the grill & call the fire department. Do not move the grill.

### Charcoal Grills:

- There are several ways to get the charcoal ready to use. Charcoal chimney starters allow you to start the charcoal using newspaper as a fuel.
- If you use a starter fluid, use only charcoal starter fluid. Never add charcoal fluid or any other flammable liquids to the fire.
- Keep charcoal fluid out of the reach of children & away from heat sources.
- There are also electric charcoal starters, which do not use fire. Be sure to use an extension cord for outdoor use.
- When you are finished grilling, let the coals completely cool before disposing in a metal container.

**Within the Village of Oak Lawn, charcoal grills or any other open-flame cooking devices, including LPG gas grills, smokers & deep fryers shall not be operated or located on any multi-family residential balcony or within ten (10) feet of combustible construction. ## Bicycle Safety

### Safety Tips for Bike Riders:


- Always wear a helmet. Helmets can prevent injuries & save lives!
- Ride on the right, in the direction of traffic, & avoid riding on busy streets.
- Be aware of traffic around you & ride in a straight line.
- Use lights when biking at night. If a child gets caught out after dark, he or she should call for a ride home.
- Be alert for obstacles in your path.
- Don't listen to music or talk on the phone while riding your bike.
- Obey all traffic laws & lights.
- Make sure your bicycle is ready to ride. Check your brakes & your wheels.
- Make sure your bike is the right size for you.

### Find the Right Helmet Fit:

- EYES check: Position the helmet on your head. Look up & you should see the bottom rim of the helmet. The rim should be one to two finger-widths above the eyebrows.
- MOUTH check: Open your mouth as wide as you can. Do you feel the helmet hug your head? If not tighten those straps & make sure the buckle is flat against your skin.
- EARS check: Make sure the straps of the helmet form a "V" under your ears when buckled. The strap should be snug but comfortable.

Use hand signals to let drivers & other bicyclists know where you're going.

#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

**The tip of a sparkler burns between 1,200 to 1,800 Degrees Fahrenheit, which is hot enough to cause third degree burns.**

#### **PROHIBITED CONSUMER FIREWORKS INCLUDE:**

**Hand Held Fireworks, Buzz Bombs, Bottle Rockets, Helicopters, Firecrackers of any size/type, Missiles, Sky Rockets, Planes, Roman Candles, Sky Lanterns\*, Chasers, Ground items other than those identified as approved consumer fireworks, and Pin Wheel or any twirling device whether on the ground or mounted above ground.**

**\*Sky lanterns, Chinese lanterns, floating lanterns or aerial luminaries, are small hot air balloons made of paper, with an opening at the bottom where a small fire is suspended. The Office of the Illinois State Fire Marshall joined other states banning the use of these fireworks on May 14, 2013.**

## Pool Safety:



### Stay Close, Be Alert & Watch Children in & Around the Pool:

- Never leave a child unattended in a pool or spa.
- Always watch your children closely around all bodies of water.
- Designate a “water watcher” to supervise children in the pool or spa. This person should not be reading, texting, using a smart phone or otherwise distracted.
- Teach children basic water safety tips.
- Keep children away from pool drains, pipes & other openings to avoid entrapments.
- Have a telephone close by when you or your family are using a pool or spa.
- If a child is missing, look for him or her in the pool or spa first.

### Have the Appropriate Equipment for Your Pool or Spa:

- Install a six-foot fence equipped with a self-closing & self-latching gate around the perimeter of the pool & spa. (VOL 6-12-3).
- Install & use a lockable safety cover on your spa \* maintain in good working condition.
- If your house serves as a fourth side of a fence around a pool, install & use a door or pool alarm.
- Ensure any pool & spa you use has drain covers that comply with federal standards, & if you do not know, ask your pool service provider whether your covers are in compliance.
- Have lifesaving equipment such as life rings, floats or a reaching pole available & easily accessible.

### Learn & Practice Water Safety:

- Learn how to swim & teach your child how to swim.
- Learn how to perform CPR on children & adults, & update those skills regularly.
- Share safety instructions with family, friends & neighbors.
- Never swim alone, or while under the influence of alcohol or medications.
- Never swim when thunder or lightning is present.




