STATE OF THE VILLAGE ADDRESS

On Tuesday, February 12, 2013, Chamber members and guests filled the Windsor room at the Hilton Hotel in Oak Lawn as they listened to Mayor Dave Heilmann present the "State of the Village" address.

The State of the Village address can be found on the Village website and is also being aired on Channel 4 or Channel 99. Highlights from the address include:

- * Neighborhood safety meetings that the Mayor has hosted with the Police Chief and 911 Emergency Communications staff, and the development of comprehensive plan for safety.
- * Development projects in Oak Lawn and the upcoming late February announcement of a major tenant at 111th and Cicero which will bring millions in new tax revenues.
- * 750-1000 new jobs coming to Oak Lawn with new developments.
- * Village expenses remaining flat and under budget.
- * Village sales taxes rebounding to near highest levels at \$12.7 million in 2012.
- * 300,000 visitors to Children's Museum since opening in 2009.
- * Oak Lawn Park District 2013 renovation for Memorial (Rocket-Slide) Park.
- * Oak Lawn Park District – New Field House at Pavilion
- * Our Children Our Government program for Oak Lawn 8th grade students who come through Village Hall and learn hands on about local government by visiting departments.

The Mayor encouraged us to lead not only within the community but as a community. He stated that this is our home and we should set our standards high and never stop seeking to improve the community. The people of Oak Lawn are its' greatest asset and strength, and because of that our future is a bright one.
